

Research Grants for Scholars in the History and Culture of Polish Jews 2009-2010

We are pleased to announce one research grant (15,000 NIS) for a scholar permanently based at a university or similar institution of higher education in Poland who is working on various aspects of the history and culture of Polish Jews.

This award will enable a scholar from Poland to spend one semester (three months) as a visiting researcher at Tel Aviv University. Fellows will be affiliated with the University's Institute for the History of Polish Jewry and Israel-Poland Relations and will enjoy full access to University libraries and archives as well as other academic services.

Fellows are expected to be in residence during either the fall (October-January) or the spring semester (March-June).

Please note that plane tickets and accommodations are the responsibility of the fellows.

Applications should be sent to the Institute by email (polin@post.tau.ac.il) and include the following materials:

- 1. An updated CV (including a list of publications)
- 2. A brief research proposal
- 3. A letter of recommendation from the department or program chair

Deadline for submission: January 31, 2009

Applicants will be informed of the Institute's decision by February 28, 2009
